Blue-green algae advisories lifted for five Calgary Zone bodies of water

CALGARY – Recent weather has cooled water temperatures in lakes to such an extent that blue-green algae is no longer a concern, including in the waters of five Calgary Zone lakes/reservoirs, which had previously been placed under blue-green algae advisory.

As such, effective immediately, Alberta Health Services has lifted the blue-green algae advisories for:

- Turner Valley Reservoir
- Travers Reservoir
- Cochrane Lake
- Severn Lake
- Eagle Lake
