province. Our council includes people who have lived
experience within the healthcare system and

and gender minority communities. Our members are
passionate about improving access and availability of
safer and more inclusive healthcare.



#### How we make a difference:

We work in partnership with Alberta Health Services (AHS) to create a safer and more welcoming healthcare environment for sexual and gender minority (lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and 2 Spirit, or LGBTQ2S+) patients and their families.

# Our role is to:

- Talk with Albertans and advise AHS what we are hearing about issues related to sexual and gender minority communities.
- Advise AHS on strategies to address stigma, bias and discrimination these communities may encounter when accessing and navigating the healthcare system.
- Help to inform how AHS supports employees who identify with these communities, and work within them.
- Advise AHS Board and AHS leadership on province wide service delivery, policy and program design to improve healthcare experiences for sexual and gender minority patients and families.
