

# Take Home Naloxone

## Getting Started – THN program

Naloxone is an unscheduled drug for emergency use in the community. Albertans can obtain it without a prescription and free of charge from all sites that are registered with the Alberta Health Services (AHS) Take Home Naloxone program.

Please follow these steps to distribute THN kits at your site.

1. Identify trainers at your site. This may include non-health care providers.
2. All trainers must complete the [eLearning module](#) (30 minutes)
3. Complete and submit the Site Registration Form
4. Complete and submit the Naloxone Kit Order Form
5. Prior to receiving a THN kit, education about opioid overdose prevention, recognition and response must be provided to the individual. You may wish to use the following resources:
