

What are the contents of kit?

Q. I have some concern with the kit containing latex gloves. As a RN who is allergic to latex and the prevalence of this allergy in the population would it not be safer to have the kit include vinyl gloves?

A. The gloves in the AHS kits are nitrile - not latex.

Q. For nursing – will all kits from AHS have the vanish point/retractable needle and vials (rather than ampoules) with rubber stop.

A. All AHS kits contain vials only. The kit has the Safety Glide syringe and needle. This has a cover that flips over the needle so that recapping is not necessary.

Q. Is the Naloxone going to be available in either the nasal route or a preload? Would we expect that bystanders may have difficulty of reluctance to using the drug when they have to draw it up themselves?

A. At this time, Naloxone in a nasal format is not licensed in Canada. It is available in the US only.
