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Background

As part of the AHS Surgical Clinical Network, the Rockyview General Hospital (RGH) is providing an innovative approach to total hip replacement surgery - Direct Anterior Total Hip Arthroplasty (DAA).

Define Opportunity (Day Surgery 24 hr Unit)

Reduced length of stay (LOS) and optimized post-surgical patient mobilization allowed RGH Surgical Services to:

- Optimize activity costs through transition of care for DAA patients from the Orthopedic inpatient unit to the Day-Surgery 24 hr Unit.


Method

Modified multi-disciplinary care approach was developed for DAA patients based on the current Alberta Bone & Joint Health Institute (ABJHI) hip arthroplasty care pathway.

- Nursing: Increased intensity of initial mobilization
- Physiotherapy: Assessment evening post-operative day #0
- (POD), earlier treatment POD#1, increased education
- Diagnostic Imaging: Evening x-ray on POD#0
- Food Services: meal provided POD#0 at 18:30

Evaluation

Patient feedback:

- Positive surgical procedure experience
- Increased satisfaction with earlier discharge
- Increased satisfaction with earlier recovery
- Identified potential opportunity for POD #0 discharge Systems Perspective:
 - Increased access to orthopedic inpatient beds
 - Assistance with site capacity and patient flow
