Lessons learned:

- Share early: Basic reports are better than none.
- Don't be afraid to report on 'unfriendly' or 'un-validated' data.
- Iterate, Iterate, Iterate.

 Reports aren't going to be perfect and feedback from the end users is required.
- Have a thick skin and open mind.



ACCOUNTABILITY FRAMEWORK (AF):


AF consists of

Quarterly reports were created and distributed via email as PDF documents.


Initial feedback was very positive but suggested that reports be more applicable to patient care and in a format easier to navigate.
