

Figure 1. Screenshot of the SCM Pharmacy Care Plan Template





#### **Template Design**

- 58% of respondents feel there is adequate space.
- 86% of respondents only required one care plan per patient per admission.
- Variable usage of medications prior to admission section was described, with some users choosing to state only 'refer to paper AHS Med Rec form'.

#### **Template Usage**

- 79% stated that they always use the template.
- 92% reported accessing care plans from previous admissions when providing care to re-admitted patients.
- 55% of respondents felt that the SCM pharmacy care plan did not impact their direct patient care activity and intervention charting.

Suggestions for the Template Improvements to the **Template** Formatting ability of SCM Increase SCM speed (bolding, make tables) Disable SCM spell check SCM speed to toggle tabs (switch between patients) Ability to create tables PCP not regularly read by Ability to 'personalize' to other healthcare clinical team / practice professionals Ability for sections to PCP is accessible by other  $shrink \rightarrow less scrolling$ healthcare professionals Consistent use among SCM to auto-save and date pharmacists by last modification

- Conflicting opinions were noted, including accessibility of the PCP by other healthcare professionals and consistency of usage of the PCP by pharmacists.
- Most suggestions for improvements were to improve inherent limitations of the SCM system including formatting, functionality, and speed.
- Another common request was to have the ability to customize the template for various different clinical teams (ie. pediatrics, critical care).

## **LESSONS LEARNED**

After review of the survey findings, change requests were submitted to the SCM team Minor modifications to the template were completed New PCP template activated within the SCM system **Provided** a Well model for utilized other SCM and good
