The Palliser Triangle Health Advisory Council area stretches from Oyen in the north to Bassano in the west, continuing eastward to the Saskatchewan border and southward to Bow Island and the United States border. Communities within the area include Bassano, Duchess, Oyen, Brooks, Redcliff, Medicine Hat, Bow Island, Desert Blume, and Foremost.



## Accomplishments

- Raised our profile through online Advisory Council meetings hosting presentations on topics which included community <u>lab services</u>, <u>addiction and mental health</u> <u>resources</u>, seniors health in the south zone, <u>Healthy Aging Alberta</u>, <u>Quality Virtual</u> <u>Care – Anytime</u>, <u>Anywhere</u> and cancer care services provided by <u>Wellspring Alberta</u>.
- Partnered with AHS to host an online community engagement session: A roundtable of Addiction and Mental Health resources in the south zone.
- Provided feedback to AHS on <u>South Zone Healthcare Planning</u>, Oyen Big County Hospital engagement session, Influenza Immunization Campaign, Aging in Place – Engagement Session for Older Albertans and Caregivers/Partners
