RE:	Changes to Sunridge Patient Service Centre Service Delivery Model

Key Message

• Effective May 10, 2021 the service delivery model for the Sunridge Patient Service Centre located at #3 -2681 36th St. NE (Sunridge Professional Building) will be changing from the current walk in only service model to:

Monday to Friday - Walk in only service 6:30am to 8:00am
APPOINTMENT ONLY service 9:00am to 6:00pm

Saturday and Sunday - Walk In service available 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Background

- The current walk in only service model results in line ups outside of our storefront Sunridge location which interferes with neighboring tenants.
- To eliminate the disruption to neighboring tenants we will offer service by appointment only at this location during hours when other tenants are open for business.
- Approximately 1600 net new appointments will be made available per week at the Sunridge location as a result of this change.

Action Required

- When ordering laboratory tests please ensure your patients who may use the Sunridge location are aware of the restrictions to walk in service on weekdays.
- Encourage your patients to book an appointment whenever possible for lab services online at www.albertaprecisonlabs.ca or by calling 403-770-5136.
