## **Key Message**

- Effective **February 14, 2022**, CO2 Fluid testing will no longer be performed at Chinook Regional Hospital in Lethbridge.
- Electrolytes Fluid testing will include Sodium, Potassium, Chloride only.
- There have been no requests for CO2 fluid in the past year, so impact should be minimal.

## How this will impact you

CO2 will not be routinely available on the Fluid electrolyte panel.

## **Action Required**

- Be aware that electrolytes fluid testing will no longer include CO2 fluid.
- Body fluid instructions have been updated.
- Test Directory has been updated to remove CO2 fluid.
