Key Message

 Genetics & Genomics has developed a <u>policy</u> outlining when carrier testing will be publicly funded for patients with Alberta health care coverage.

Background

• In September 2020, the Genetic Resource Centre published a policy for funding out-of-province genetic carrier testing. This policy has been updated, and now applies to send-outs **and** requests for in-house carrier testing offered through Genetics & Genomics.

How this will impact you

• This policy provides information regarding when carrier testing will be publicly funded for patients with Alberta health care coverage.

Action Required

• **Review the** policy. For patients who are not eligible for publicly funded testing, it is the responsibility of the clinician to discuss the option of private-pay testing if deemed appropriate.
