# **Key Message**

- A new provincial <u>APL Blood Product Pick Up Slip</u> (form CH-0037) is now available.
- This form replaces existing Pick-Up Slips in North, Edmonton, and South Zones and will replace downtime Pick-Up Slips / Dispense requests in Calgary and Central Zones as sites go live on Connect Care.
- Legacy pick-up slips may continue to be used until supplies are depleted.

### **Background**

- A variety of Blood Product Pick-Up slips exist across the province.
- In Connect Care, the Pick-Up slip is generated by Epic. However, during downtime, a manual Pick-Up slip is required.

# How this will impact you

- **Sites live on Connect Care:** The APL Blood Product Pick-Up Slip is a downtime form only. Continue to use the Epic-generated pick up slip for routine use.
- **North Zone** sites not on Connect Care: APL Blood Product Pick-Up Slip replaces the legacy North Zone Blood Bank Pickup Slip.
- Edmonton Zone sites not on Connect Care: the new form will be automatically substituted on ordering.
- Central Zone: Continue using the Meditech Order until until Connect Care goes live at your site.
- Calgary Zone: Continue using the SCM-generated or manual Dispense Request until Connect Care goes live at your site.
- **South Zone**: APL Blood Product Pick-Up Slip replaces the legacy South Zone Transfusion Pickup Slip (C-2288). Order through the South Zone Print Shop using your current practice.

#### **Action Required**

- North, Edmonton, and South Zones: When replenishing supplies of Pick-Up Slips, use the new <u>APL Blood</u> Product Pick Up Slip (CH-0037)

  - o Through Data CM as a 4x4 pad of 100 slips (search form CH-0037)
