## **Key Message**

- Effective February 7, 2022, Calcium Fluid testing will no longer be performed at Chinook Regional Hospital in Lethbridge.
- Testing will be referred to the Diagnostic Scientific Centre in Calgary.

### How this will impact you

- Requests for Calcium Fluid are infrequent. Testing requires acidification prior to analysis so consolidating testing in Calgary will provide greater consistency in sample handling and result quality.
- Referral of testing will result in an increased turnaround time for this test.

### **Action Required**

- Order CAFLURO for Calcium, fluid testing. Refer to the <u>APL Test Directory: Calcium, Fluid Calgary Zone</u> for specimen collection instructions.
- Body fluid instructions have been updated.
