Key Message

- Effective **February 7, 2022**, Stool pH testing will no longer be performed at Chinook Regional Hospital in Lethbridge.
- Testing will be referred to the Alberta Children's Hospital in Calgary.

How this will impact you

- Requests for Stool pH are infrequent and generally not urgent.
- Centralizing testing to Calgary will result in prolonged turnaround times for this test.

Action Required

- Order PHSTLRO for Stool pH testing. Refer to the <u>APL Test Directory: pH, Stool Calgary Zone</u> for specimen collection instructions.
- Stool sample should be delivered to the laboratory immediately after collection.
