Key Message

- Effective August 31, 2021 at Magrath Health Center Hospital, there will be a temporary change to laboratory and x-ray services. Laboratory services will be available three days per week and x-ray services available two days per week.
- This temporary service change will end upon successful recruitment and is due to staffing/recruitment challenges. Our hiring efforts continue and we will reopen as soon as we are able to.
- The safety of our patients and staff is at the heart of every decision we make. This is a temporary
 measure to ensure safe and high-quality care for patients, and a quality work environment for staff.
 APL continues to look for solutions to address staffing needs.
- Combined laboratory and x-ray technologists are in high demand across the province, creating significant staffing challenges across South Zone.
