Key Message

• Troponin testing at the following sites will be referred to an alternate site for testing and reporting effective immediately: Sheldon M Chumir Health Center, South Calgary Health Center, Cochrane Community Health Center, Airdrie Health Center, Okotoks Health and Wellness Center, and Banff Mineral Springs Hospital.

Background

• Due to an urgent vendor recall, on-site testing of high sensitivity troponin I on the miniVIDAS instruments will be temporarily suspended. Replacement testing reagent has been secured and is expected to arrive by the end of day October 1, 2021 at which time on-site testing will resume.

How this will impact you

• Orders for high sensitivity troponin will be prioritized as STAT and transported to a referral site and reported as follows. It is expected that turn-around times will be increased due to necessary transport.
