

Laboratory Services Provincial Quality Improvement Council Terms of Reference

Purpose

The Laboratory Provincial Quality Improvement Council (PQIC) is a standing committee with the primary purpose of overseeing the quality management system which is the foundation for continual improvement in quality objectives, risk management, patient safety, utilization management, and accreditation for Laboratory Services at the provincial level. The Council is also responsible for overseeing and providing quality improvement direction to Zone and Program Quality Councils.

The Council accomplishes this by

Goal setting, establishing and monitoring quality indicators, identifying priority areas for
process improvement, and the overall evaluation of quality for Laboratory Services.
Ensuring, alignment of initiatives and activities with Alberta Health Services (AHS) strategic
direction, goals, and overall operations of the organization.
Fostering a culture of continuous quality improvement through strong leadership, effective
communication and clear expectations.

Accountability

The PQIC is accountable to the Laboratory Dyad Leadership team, Laboratory Services.

Management System; Establishing, reviewing, and monitoring indicators of quality for the province for purposes of			
identifying provincial initiatives;			
 Reviewing recommendations from Zone and Program Quality Councils for purposes of identifying provincial initiatives; 			
 Identifying and prioritizing quality initiatives consistent with Laboratory Services' goals and objectives and in alignment with AHS strategic direction; 			
□ Overseeing and directing the work of Zone and Program Quality Councils and ensuring their			
alignment with the goals of the QIC. The Laboratory Provincial Quality Improvement Council will review and approve quality			
reports from Zone and Program Quality Councils

Meetings

Frequency

Meetings will be held quarterly and as necessary at the request of the Chair. The Chair, in his or her sole discretion, will determine whether there are sufficient members to proceed with the QIC meeting.

Quorum

Quorum consists of a minimum of 50% + 1 of all regular members and must include the Provincial Medical / Scientific Director or designate and one other medical / scientific representative from an alternate zone or program area.

Agenda and Minutes

An agenda and supporting materials will be circulated to members at least one week in advance of the scheduled meeting. Minutes of each meeting will be recorded and circulated to members. All records will be maintained as per AHS standards.
