	 You must NOT be pregnant A minimum of an 8 hour fast IS necessary. Fasting is defined as nothing to eat, chew (including gum or candies), or drink other than small amounts of water. Prescription medication is permitted. 		
Risks or Cautions	 You must remain at the laboratory for the duration of the test (approx. 2-2.5 hour) If you start to feel ill, let laboratory staff know You may not smoke, eat, chew (including gum or candy), or drink other than small amounts of water during the test. 		
Collecting the Sample	 You will have a fasting blood specimen drawn and checked for a glucose level. If the glucose level is outside the prescribed test limits, your doctor will be notified and the test may be cancelled. You will be given a glucose drink You will have 5 minutes to consume the drink Your blood will be drawn 2 hours after glucose drink is given
