



Little Warriors is a national charitable organization, based in Canada, focusing on the education and prevention of child sexual abuse. Little Warriors teaches adults how to help prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse.

Little Warriors is offering Darkness to Light's **Stewards of Children** program. It is a revolutionary, three hour sexual abuse prevention training program that educates adults to help prevent child sexual abuse, and motivates them to courageous action. The Stewards of Children program is designed for parents, youth serving organizations, schools and any professional working and/or volunteering with children.

1 in 3 girls and 1 in 6 boys will be sexually abused before their 18th birthday. 95% of them will know their perpetrator.

The Stewards of Children curriculum is useful for parents, professionals or organizations who are

- seeking training for staff and volunteers in the prevention of child sexual abuse.
- wanting to make a difference in their community
- needing to respond to insurance requirements regarding child protection
- seeking Continuing Education Credits. The Stewards of Children program is approved for 3 Category A Credits with ACSW, 3 Continuing Education Units with the Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association, 3 Continuing Competence Program Credits with the College of Registered Dental Hygienists' of Alberta and the Saskatchewan Dental Hygienists' Association.

The program includes

- an interactive workbook for each participant containing the full program curriculum
- an accompanying 1 ¼ hour DVD integrating segments of sexual abuse survivors relating their stories of violation and healing, with segments from the author of the curriculum and from professionals who interface daily with the problem of sexual abuse
- opportunity for discussion about important issues in sexual abuse prevention and the relevance of these issues within organizations that serve children and adolescents.

After training participants will

- understand the facts of child sexual abuse – incidence rates and effects on individuals and society
- understand how child sexual abuse happens
- understand that adults are responsible for the protection of children
- understand the importance of screening staff/volunteers who work with children and adolescents
- understand the importance of a well conceived one-adult/one-child policy
- have resources to react responsibly to incidents of child sexual abuse
- understand the proactive role youth-serving organizations need to take to protect children and educate their communities about child sexual abuse
- receive a certificate of attendance

Is there a fee for the program?

Yes, there is a fee for our program. We are a non-profit, charitable organization and we have to cover our costs to deliver this program. Each participant receives a manual, a handbook and a certificate. The fees are \$30 per person, \$25 per person for groups of 2-30 people, \$20 per person for non profit groups of 10-30 people. If a facilitator is required to travel; mileage, accommodations, a food allowance and shipping of materials may also apply.



Can I host a session at my organization, school, or for a group I have put together?

Simply complete a Group Booking Form to have a facilitator come out to your group to do a session. We ask for a couple of date options to match our availability. Once we have received your form you will receive confirmation of what date we are able to accommodate. We ask that there is a minimum of 10 people for a group session and a maximum of 30 people.

For a session at my location what do I need to provide?

A room that is available for a 4 hour time slot with enough chairs for participants. If you chose to provide snacks and drinks that is up to you; Little Warriors does not provide this. We ask that the venue has a TV and DVD or a laptop, projector and speakers. If you are not able to provide equipment and someone to operate please let us know before booking. Please note there may be a charge for equipment to be brought or rented.

What do I need to do to prepare for the session at my location?

3-5 days prior to the session, the Regional Program Coordinator will contact you to ask for a list of names of the registered participants. This will allow us to prepare certificates for each person that is attending. On the day of the session, please ensure that your room is set up with chairs for enough participants and a TV and DVD or laptop and screen with speakers. Be prepared to meet the facilitator at the location ½ hour before the session is to start so they have time to get set up.
