Calgary Vaccination Clinics Update

CALGARY – Calgary’s three influenza vaccination clinics will continue offering H1N1 vaccine the week of January 11th to all individuals over six months of age. These clinics are scheduled to operate from Monday to Saturday through January 16th.

For individuals in high risk groups, seasonal influenza vaccine is also available at these clinics.

Future AHS vaccination clinic dates and locations will be scheduled according to demand seen in our clinics over the next week. Details will be announced as finalized.

Vaccination is the single best defense against influenza, and AHS strongly recommends that all Albertans over six months of age get vaccinated.
