Q: *Who is funding the Calgary Metropolitan Foundation? For how much money? Has the City of Calgary quit funding?*

A: Alberta Health Services, Calgary Zone does not fund the Calgary Metropolitan Foundation nor was funding provided by the Former Calgary Health Region as they are considered a housing operator.

Alberta Health Services, Calgary Zone provides Home Care services to eligible residents that live in the Calgary Metropolitan Lodges in the same way we provide care to clients living in their private homes. Integrated Seniors Health, Calgary Zone is piloting a program in some of their lodges where Home Care is providing the contracted care vendor with an extra Health Care Aide during the night.

Q: What is the history of the “Bentall” building previously “public” land and facility?

A: The Sheldon Chumir building is owned by Alberta Health Services. Bentall is currently the third party property manager for the site and were the development team lead as a partner with Alberta Health Services on the project.
