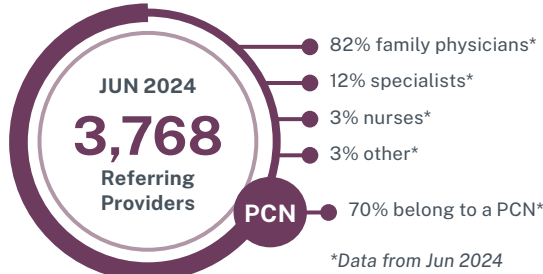

Referring provider usage of FAST is growing.

Referrals are processed quickly.



**Processing time excludes referrals that are declined, cancelled, deferred, incomplete or in clerical triage.

FAST is working to reduce administrative burden on referring and receiving providers.



Standardized referral requirements via Referral Pathways



Support to address missing documentation on incomplete referrals



New functionality in eReferral to reduce declined referrals



Referrals assigned by provider, site, or next available surgeon



Centralized intake via one fax number per zone (one per specialty in Edmonton Zone)

92.5% of incomplete referrals submitted between Jan-Jun 2024 were supported to completion

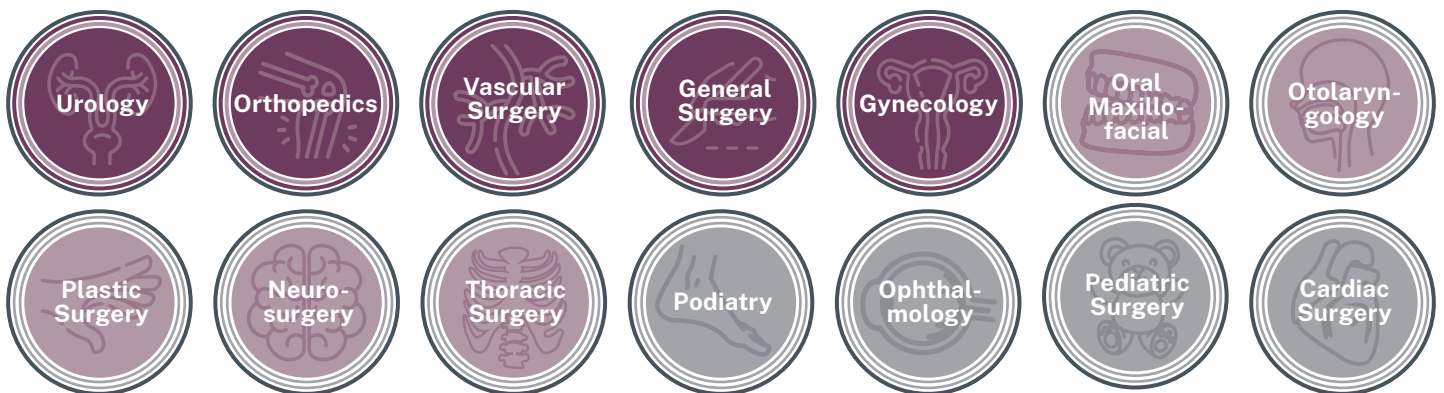
Referrals can be redirected rather than declined

● Specialties in co-design or partnership process

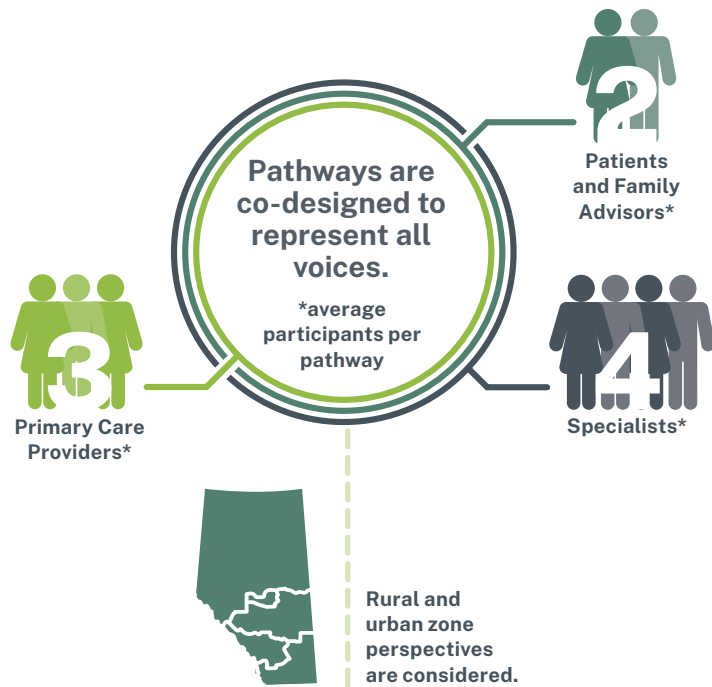

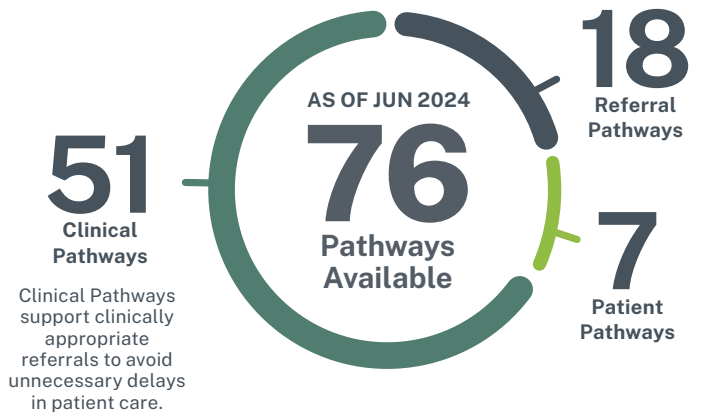
