Standardized referral requirements via Referral Pathways



Centralized intake via one fax number per zone (one per specialty in Edmonton Zone)



Support to address missing documentation on incomplete referrals

84.6% of incomplete referrals submitted between Jan-Dec 2024 were supported to completion



New functionality in eReferral to reduce declined referrals

Referrals can be redirected rather than declined



Referrals assigned by provider, site, or next available surgeon


