**Re: Notice Confirming Assignment of Services Agreement reference number CLM208233,  
between Alberta Health Services (“AHS”) and Bradley Fisher Professional Corporation  
(the “Service Provider”) as amended (the “Agreement”)**

On February 1, 2025, Acute Care Alberta was formally established as a Provincial Health Agency under the *Provincial Health Agencies Act* (Alberta). Effective April 1, 2025, Acute Care Alberta will oversee the governance and coordination of provision of Chartered Surgical Facility or Bone and Joint Access services in Alberta. As part of the transition of these services from AHS to Acute Care Alberta, the Minister of Health has ordered that, effective April 1, 2025 (the “**Assignment Date**”), the Agreement, together with all of AHS’ rights, benefits, obligations and responsibilities associated with the Agreement, will be assigned from AHS to Acute Care Alberta (the “**Assignment**”).

Applicable AHS teams will continue to support the transition to Acute Care Alberta. Further details of these arrangements are set out in the attachment to this Notice.
