## RESOLUTION OF THE OFFICIAL ADMINISTRATOR OF ALBERTA HEALTH SERVICES

**WHEREAS** this Resolution is enacted pursuant to Section 11(1) of the *Provincial Health Agencies Act* (Alberta) and Ministerial Order 808/2025, appointing Andre Tremblay as the Official Administrator of Alberta Health Services ("**AHS**") (the "**Official Administrator**");

**AND WHEREAS** in accordance with the *Provincial Health Agencies Act* (Alberta), the AHS 2025-26 Budget requires approval by the Official Administrator.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Official Administrator:

- 1. Approve the AHS 2025-26 Budget, based on AHS' current structure, in the form reviewed by the Official Administrator, with such non-substantive changes that management of AHS considers necessary or advisable;
- 2. Approve the following 2025-26 funding amounts for the three wholly-owned subsidiaries of AHS, as provided for in the 2025-26 Budget:
  - a. \$958 million of unrestricted base operating funding for Alberta Precision Laboratories Ltd.;
  - b. \$203 million of unrestricted base operating funding for Carewest; and
  - c. \$172 million of unrestricted base operating funding for CapitalCare Group Inc.; and
- 3. Authorize and direct management of AHS to deliver the 2025-26 Budget to the Minister of Health for approval.

The foregoing resolutions are hereby consented to by the Official Administrator as evidenced by the signature hereto, effective the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2025.
