# [QSC18-22] Alberta Health Services Infection Prevention and Control 2017/18 Annual Report to Alberta Health

UPON MOTION duly moved, seconded and unanimously carried the Alberta Health Services Board approved the 2017/18 Infection Prevention and Control Annual Report for submission to Alberta Health.

### [FC18-47] Q1 2018-19 Investment Report

UPON MOTION duly moved, seconded and unanimously carried the Alberta Health Services Board ratified the investment portfolio and transactions as described below, and as certified by signed investment compliance certificates from AHS and Phillips, Hager & North Investment Management:

- (a) as at June 30, 2018, AHS held restricted and unrestricted funds managed by Phillips, Hager & North Investment Management and Manulife Financial totalling \$1.523 billion;
- (b) the funds were invested in short term treasury bills, federal, provincial and corporate fixed income bonds, pooled mortgage funds, bond funds, Canadian and Global equity funds; and
- (c) all of the funds invested during the quarter ended June 30, 2018, were invested in accordance with the Investment Bylaw and Investments Policy as certified by signed investment compliance certificates from AHS and Phillips, Hager & North Investment Management.

# [FC18-48] Delegation of Authority Over \$90M Master Services Agreement: Walden Heights Seniors Community Inc.
