



Community Update:

Fort McMurray Continuing Care Centre (Willow Square)

Overview

- Construction of the \$110 million Willow Square Continuing Care Centre (WSCCC) is underway.
- When the project is completed, Fort McMurray will have a modern continuing care centre that will help meet many community needs for seniors and residents of all ages with disabilities.
- There will be 108 beds available on opening day (36 spaces will be shelled for future development).

- Residents are anticipated to move-in during late 2020.
- The WSCCC is being built on 70% of the Willow Square site and the remaining 30% will be used for future developments as needed.







Construction update

- Construction of the Willow Square Continuing Care Centre is well underway.
- Design is completed.
- Steel frame structure is completed.
- Building is closed in, roof is completed.
- Drywall 90% is completed.
- Underground parkade is paved.



What's to come

- Early 2020: Construction is expected to be completed.
- Early 2020: After construction is complete AHS will begin commissioning work which includes final cleaning of the entire building, the installation of furniture and equipment. It also includes training staff to use the new medical equipment and systems, and building systems to ensure they are working properly.
- Mid 2020: Continuing Care Centre is expected to begin welcoming guests.
