

## **LETTER OF SUPPORT from the BJH SCN – General Guidelines**

To support and facilitate the work of the BJH SCN community, we provide letters of support to individuals, organizations and/or initiatives that complement the work and areas of focus of the BJH SCN. The following aims to outline a process for requesting letters of support in order for the BJH SCN leadership to be effectively responsive.

If you would like to request a Letter of Support (LOS) from the BJH SCN:

- 1) Read the general guidelines below
- 2) Submit your request for a letter of support via email to Ania Kania-Richmond (<a href="mailto:anna.kania-richmond@ahs.ca">anna.kania-richmond@ahs.ca</a>). The following information must be provided:
  - I. Title of project, initiative etc. for which support is being requested
  - II. Name of individual submitting the request
  - III. Role of the individual submitting the request in relation to the project, initiative, etc. (e.g. principal investigator, project manager, collaborator etc.)
  - IV. Clear statement specifying the type of support being requested of the BJH SCN (see below)
  - V. Statement of how the request aligns with or links to BJH SCN areas of focus (see below)

## **General Guidelines**

All Letters of Support requests will be pre-screened to determine eligibility – which is based on alignment with BJH SCN scope and type of request (see request form). **Turnaround time for LOS is a minimum of 5 business days.** We may contact you to request additional information or for clarification of submitted requests and/or material(s).



A request for a letter of support must align with or link to *at least one* of the following areas:

Prevention (primary, secondary and tertiary) of bone and joint conditions  Management and treatment of bone and joint conditions  -conservative (nonsurgical)  -approaches surgical interventions	AND/OR	BJH SCN signature projects, priority projects, and/or research projects	AND/OR	Not aligned with current focus or on-going project but relevant to bone and joint health and services in Alberta

## Requests may be for, but not limited to:

- Support of concept defined as agreement that this topic area is worthy of additional study/research
- Support of the researcher or research team (strength, expertise, etc.)
- Endorsement (for proposed project, initiative, etc.)
- In kind support (to support specific activities and/or processes within an initiative)
- Funding
