

PAIN




8% improvement in the compliance of completing q4hr pain assessments on all ICU patients


Remember * this only captures assessments charted within a pain scale ...does not include comments made.

MANAGEMENT OF PAIN


- Treat pain first & minimize sedatives!
- Assess pain minimum of q4h and chart in MetaVision using CPOT, NRS, VAS or FLACC scales.
- Document the <u>reassessment of pain</u> using CPOT, NRS, VAS or FLACC scales, post intervention.
- Pre-procedural pain management
- Non-pharmacological pain management interventions



DELIRIUM



7.8% reduction in proportion of patient days with delirium in Alberta adult ICUs



Screening for delirium has increased by 32% since last year!


