- Develop a cardiac imaging IT roadmap with initial focus on Echocardiography
- Build an economic model of stroke and cardiac rehabilitation
- Use data and evidence to consult on health system utilization
- Increase focus on remote monitoring and telehealth

- Build Clinical Pathways (e.g. heart failure, chest pain)
- Develop device clinic guidelines and STEMI order sets
- Actively involving patients and their families in our work
- Develop and implement clinical dashboards for quality management
