

Call for Application

Diabetes, Obesity & Nutrition Strategic Clinical Network™ Undergraduate 2020 Studentship Competition



Purpose

The Diabetes, Obesity & Nutrition Strategic Clinical Network[™] (DON SCN[™]) 2020 Undergraduate Summer Studentship program is designed to provide funding support to undergraduate students to participate in research and develop research skills related to glycemic management in hospital, bariatric care in hospital, and/or to the Diabetic Foot Care Clinical Pathway, which are initiatives currently being led by the DON SCN[™]. The Scientific Office of the DON SCN[™] has created one Studentship Award which will provide funding in the amount of \$ 1,500 /month for a maximum of 4 months (**\$ 6,000**) and the award is non-renewable.

The student will be supervised by the Assistant Scientific Director of the DON SCNTM. This competition aims to meet the DON SCNTM Research and Innovation objectives of: a) fostering the development of researchers through the training and mentorship of students, and b) collaborating on research related to the priority areas of the DON SCN.

Eligibility

When considering the application, the review process will consider the following criteria:

- Studentship applicants must be enrolled or accepted as a full-time student in an undergraduate program at an approved post-secondary academic institution;
- Holders of other full-time, major studentship awards (e.g. CIHR, NSERC, AI, etc.) are ineligible for Studentship awards;
- Students must be enrolled in a health-related faculty or program.

Reporting

A final progress report will be submitted at the end of the award period. The final report will provide a summary of the research activities accomplished during the training period.

Knowledge Dissemination

Synopses of the research studies conducted by the award recipients will be shared with the SCN Core Committee and published both in SCN newsletters and the SCN website.



Evaluation of the Applications

Review panel members will independently review each application and score them according to the following assessment criteria using a 5-point scale.

- 1. Student academic record
- 2. Research experience
- 3. Alignment of the project with students' future plans
- 4. Letters of Reference

Application Process

For Submission:

- i) Official transcript(s)
- ii) Two letters of reference (academic)
- iii) Paragraph on how the research studentship at the DON SCN[™] aligns with future career plans (200 words)
- iv) Curriculum vitae

Complete applications should be submitted in ONE PDF file to Dr. Naomi Popeski (naomi.popeski@ahs.ca), Assistant Scientific Director of DON SCN[™] no later than **February 13, 2020 at 4:00pm**. Letters of reference should be emailed separately and directly from the referee to Dr. Naomi Popeski. Letters must be written on institutional letterhead and attached as a PDF file to the email, not written in the body of the email.
