
Working Together

Current Working Groups:

- **Data Working Group** launched to enable evidence-informed decision-making by the SCN, its Sections and Working Groups, by identifying analytic needs, facilitating access to data and creating analytic products (analyses, dashboards, reporting, etc.).
- Long-COVID Working Group launched to support the management of patients with Long-COVID by developing strategies and tools to harmonize the provincial approach to clinical services and prospective evaluation, with a focus on specialty care and primary-specialty care integration.
