
Vision

Progress

The project is transitioning between Stages 1 and 2 with:

• Interviews with persons with spinal cord injury (SCI) and SCI stakeholders to elicit information about their experiences, have been completed. See below for breakdown.



- Analysis of collected interview data is currently ongoing.
- SCI stakeholder meeting scheduled for March 24, 2021 to react to Stage 1 findings and collaborate on prioritizing identified needs and solutions, which will serve as input in Stage 2.
- Modified Delphi process was adopted by the project's Evaluation Working Group. Round 1, to identify relevant evaluation tools, measures, indicators and criteria that would be most significant has been completed.
