Medical Officer or Health (MOH)			
□ At MOH discretion, in conjunction with IP&C organize and facilitate outbreak management meetings including the Site Manager, Unit Manager, ES, pharmacy, physicians and MOH as available			
□ May close the unit to admissions and transfers as required and make determination for reopening			
□ Consider restricting visitors during high burden of cases if a volunteer cannot be recruited to communicate with and teach visitors about correct hand hygiene and use of PPE			
□ May consider strain typing of positive isolates together with lab virologist
