Isolation Cart – Key Points

Central Zone Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

When setting up the isolation cart **always refer** to the type of isolation required as per the Diseases and Conditions Table.

Cart set-up

- Alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) must be on the cart or readily available.
- Cleaner/disinfectant and <u>only</u> the personal protective equipment (PPE) required for the specific isolation, no other supplies to be on the cart.
- Storage space must be adequate for all supplies needed. If unable to **protect supplies** from environment, store in drawers or covered containers.
- Choose from the cart the appropriate additional precaution poster to place on the door. Additional
 Precaution posters are available on the appropriate tab for the resource manuals <u>Acute Care</u> or
 <u>Continuing Care</u>.
- Choose additional posters to place on the door:
