# Management of Respiratory Illness for Continuing Care Homes Central Zone Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

## Symptomatic resident is identified

#### **Initiate Infection Control Measures**

Place on contact and droplet precautions and swab for respiratory organisms

If **two (2) or more linked** respiratory illness cases are identified within a 7-day period

call AHS Population Public Health Support Team
(PPHST) Line at 1-844-343-0971

## Notify the following departments as applicable:

- Site Leadership / On-call Manager (after hours)
- Site Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)
- Workplace Health and Safety (WHS) (symptomatic

# Communicable Disease Control (CDC) will connect with the facility

- El number will be provided
- Send RPP specimens for all symptomatic residents, include EI # if known.

If outbreak is confirmed, initiate the Respiratory Outbreak Checklist

### Site Leadership to Distribute Communications

Follow the zone-specific process to notify all other areas

### One resident with symptoms:

- If the resident is exhibiting at least ONE core respiratory symptom: fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose/nasal congestion, loss of taste and/or smell, decrease in oxygen (O<sub>2</sub>) saturation level or increased O<sub>2</sub> requirements, nausea or diarrhea, submit an NP swab for the Respiratory Pathogen Panel (RPP).
- Initiate infection control measures:
  - $\checkmark$  Monitor for additional symptomatic residents.
  - ✓ Post signs (precautions, donning/doffing) outside of required rooms.
  - ✓ Arrange for tray service as required.
  - ✓ Ensure staff are wearing appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) based on IPC RA (Risk Assessment).
  - ✓ Always follow the 4 Moments of hand hygiene.

If an outbreak is declared an initial outbreak meeting is encouraged to facilitate communication.

- Initiate outbreak control measures:
  - ✓ Continuous masking and eye protection.
  - ✓ Enhanced cleaning and disinfection.
  - ✓ PPE Safety Coach support.
  - ✓ Hand hygiene reviews if work capacity allows.
