# Respiratory Illness Management in AHS LTC/DSL/Hospice Settings Central Zone Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)

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If you are caring for a resident living in a congregate care facility who develops symptoms of respiratory illness, the resident must be immediately placed on modified respiratory precautions. Follow the algorithm below:

# Symptomatic resident identified by unit staff/manager

#### **Initiate Infection Control Measures**

If the resident is exhibiting at least **ONE** core symptom<sup>1</sup> submit swab for COVID-19, Influenza A and B and RSV

If 2 or more linked resident and/or staff cases are identified within 7 days, call AHS Population Public Health Support Team (PPHST) Line at 1-844-343-0971

## Notify the following departments:

- Site Leadership / On-Call Manager
- Site Infection Prevention and Control (IPC)
- Workplace Health and Safety (WHS)

# **Communicable Disease Control (CDC)** will connect with the facility

- El number will be provided
- Record EI number on lab requisition
- Collect COVID-19 and RPP swabs for symptomatic residents

# If outbreak is confirmed, initiate the Outbreak **Management Checklists**

## Site Leadership to Distribute Communications

Follow the zone specific process to notify all other areas

For a resident exhibiting symptoms - initiate Infection Control Measures:

- Post signs (precautions, donning/doffing) outside of required rooms
- Arrange for tray service as required
- Staff to wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) based on IPC RA (Risk Assessment)
- Follow strict hand hygiene at all times
- Monitor for additional symptomatic residents

If an outbreak is declared an initial outbreak meeting is encouraged to facilitate communication of the outbreak. Initiate:

- Continuous masking and eye protection
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfection
- PPE Safety Coach support
- Hand hygiene reviews if work capacity allows
