A way of identifying the risk of exposure to an organism associated with a person, oneself, a task and the environment.

Why:


To stop the transmission of an infectious illness. Performed by both clinical and non-clinical staff.

How:


Involves thinking through the links of the chain of infection and what actions you might take to break the chain and reduce exposure risk.

When:

Should be performed for every encounter with a person, task or environment anytime exposure to an organism might be possible.
