FOR THE DONNING PROCEDURE USE A CHALLENGE RESPOND METHOD

<p>CHALLENGE RESPOND = HCW completes checklist actions. After completion of sequence, Buddy reads off checklist item (CHALLENGE) HCW confirms they have completed checklist item (RESPOND)</p>	
<p>1. PREPARATION</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pull hair back, secure off neck and face • Remove all extra items on person 	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
<p>2. HAND HYGIENE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perform hand hygiene, using alcohol based hand rub <p>If your hands look or feel dirty use soap and water</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>3. LEG COVERS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sit on chair or stool. Fit leg covers over shoes and pull up as high as they will go • Tie leg cover ties around ankles 	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
<p>4. HAND HYGIENE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perform hand hygiene, using alcohol based hand rub 	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>5. INNER GLOVES (SURGICAL)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put on surgical gloves 	<input type="checkbox"/>
<p>6. FLUID IMPERVIOUS GOWN</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Put on gown. • Ensure cuffs of gloves are under cuffs of gown • Make sure gown covers from neck to knees and sleeves come down to wrists • Tie at back of neck and waist • If there are two sets of ties at waist (inside and outside), tie outer waist ties only <p>Buddy assists with ties</p>	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
