
If your child gets sicker while in the hospital, tell your nurse or your doctor.

What is the STEP Team?

The STEP Team is the Alberta Children's Hospital's (ACH) ICU outreach team and stands for Support Team for Emergency Prevention.

The STEP Team is made up of pediatric intensive care doctors, nurses and respiratory therapists who are experts in the care of sick children.

The STEP Team can be called by any healthcare providers throughout the hospital to assess children who are getting sicker, despite the treatment they are receiving.

STEP also provides follow up visits to all children transferred out of the ICU to another unit at the ACH and for some children transferred from the emergency department.

Parent or Family Activation of the STEP Team

You know your child best. If you feel your child's condition is getting worse and are worried, **TALK TO YOUR NURSE OR TO A DOCTOR.**

If you continue to be worried or have a "gut" feeling that something is not right, parents and families can directly call for the STEP Team.

The STEP Team will examine your child, talk to you and your doctors and nurses, and come up with a plan together.

The entire healthcare team is here to support you and activating the STEP Team is a standard part of how you or your healthcare team calls for help if it is needed at the ACH.
