

Project Facts: Arthur J.E. Child Comprehensive Cancer Centre



The building is 127,000 square metres (1.3 million square feet) not including the connector and underground parking.



450,000 m³ of dirt was removed as part of site excavation. This is equivalent to 5.2 million wheelbarrows full.



The building includes over 6,600 spaces and rooms.



There are a total of 13 floors above ground and 5 levels below.



The building has thousands of items including:

- 2,600 workstations
- 300 patient lifts
- 1,900 guest seats



900+ user consultations design meetings with 600+ users to ensure the facility was designed to meet their needs.



There is approx. 3,800 doors, meaning a person could open a new door every day for 10.4 years.



The building has approx. 1,200 hand hygiene sinks, someone could wash their hands in a different sink each day for 3.2 years.



Over 10,000 drawings were reviewed in designing the building.



The building received LEED Gold certification.



Over 7 million hours worked (end of Oct 2021).



Patient & Family Advisors have volunteered over 4,800 hours with the project since 2014.
