The Green Hospital Scorecard looks at how hospitals manage waste and recyclable materials.


RGH waste is considered for reuse, recycling or composting. Paper, plastic, electronics, batteries and construction debris are recycled.

RGH has a full collection of compostable waste in our patient


food services kitchen and retail food services kitchen and cafeteria. Garburators challenge the capacity of our wastewater system in both collection and treatment and are no longer used at RGH.

Styrofoam cups and plates have been replaced with a compostable equivalent since 2019.


General Waste (non-hazardous)
