Should you require urgent assistance due to an emergency such as:

- Illness
- Ketones
- Missed insulin doses
- Persistent low blood glucose levels

Monday to Friday from 8 am - 4 pm, please page the nurses at 780 445-1860

- 1. Page and wait 10 minutes for a phone call back.
- 2. Page a second time and wait 10 minutes for a phone call back.
- 3. If there is still no answer, please follow step 2 below

Weekends, evenings and holidays: please page the doctor at 780–407–8822

1. Ask for the Pediatric Endocrinologist on Call (Kids Diabetes Doctor)

For insulin adjustments call 780-407-7033, fax 780-407-1509 or email pdec.uah@ahs.ca the following information:

- 1. Your child's first name, last name, and date of birth
- 2. Five days of blood glucose levels
- 3. Current insulin dose and what adjustments you feel is needed
- 4. Treatment of any lows or any activity
- 5. Alberta Healthcare Number
