

# UPDATES TO PROVINCIAL ADULT VASCULAR REFERRAL PATHWAY

### April 1, 2025

• Changed the pathway to reflect the new process in Calgary zone for non-urgent vascular referrals.

### January 28, 2025

Changed colour of advice platforms from red to blue in the process column for Symptomatic Carotid Artery
Disease and Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) -Asymptomatic AP or Transverse Diameter Female ≥6.0cm/
Male ≥6.5cm. Purpose: To clarify that urgent advice is not required, but that non-urgent advice should be
sought to arrange an urgent referral,
