Course Description

This course introduces fundamental patient safety concepts and examines the influence culture has on patient safety outcomes. A culture of safety in any setting “reflects an organizational understanding that the delivery of safe care requires an ongoing commitment to continuous improvement” (HQA, 2017). The course will outline the recommended practices and principles to foster a culture of patient safety and look at how Alberta’s Health Agencies are developing their own patient safety culture. Participants will also examine their own role in maintaining and enhancing patient safety in their organizations
