Course Description

Patient safety improvement is a vital component of creating and sustaining a culture of patient safety in healthcare. An increasing number of patient safety improvement initiatives are identified through active measuring and monitoring of patient safety risks and clinical adverse events and other measures.

In order to participate in improvement activities, it is necessary to understand how patient safety initiatives are prioritized, the role metrics, measures and data play in framing the patient safety event and how recommendations for improvement are disseminated through the organization. This course is designed to guide participants through this process using real time patient safety measures and metrics to analyze patient safety data in order to write recommendations for potential safety improvement initiatives to be shared within the organization.
