## Community and Regional Centre Cancer Patient Navigators

These are Cancer Patient Navigators who work at the community or regional cancer centres in Alberta. They work with all cancer patients in their area even if they are getting treatment at a different centre. They are the local experts and have the ability to connect you to supports in Cancer Care Alberta, as well as local resources.

### Indigenous Cancer Patient Navigators

Indigenous Cancer Patient Navigators work with and support First Nations, Métis, and Inuit peoples impacted by cancer. They can help with navigating the healthcare system and answering questions, providing support and connection to resources and services, and advocating to have questions and concerns addressed.

### Adolescent and Young Adult (AYA) Patient Navigators

AYA Cancer Patient Navigators help people 17-39 years old live well with and beyond cancer. They can provide information and education, and help with the unique needs and common concerns that young adults with cancer have.

#### Services are free and confidential.

You or your healthcare team can make a referral, at any point from diagnosis to after treatment.
