

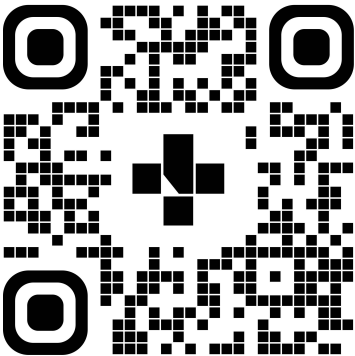
Digital Tools for People Considering Genetic Testing

To use a QR code, open the **camera** app on your device and hover over the square (below) until a link appears. **Touch the link on the screen** to view the information.

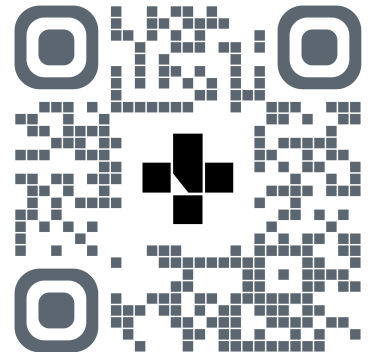
