

ECG Written Textual Reports Available Via eDelivery

Change Date: June 23, 2026

What is changing:

ECG written textual reports (interpretation only) can be sent to EMRs starting June 23.

What you need to know:

- When eDelivery is a provider's preferred delivery method, ECG written textual reports (interpretation only) will be sent to the EMR of the ordering/authorizing provider and any copy to providers.
- ECG eDelivery reports will be similar to the reports faxed from Connect Care (Epic).
- No waveform tracings will be included in the reports sent to EMRs.
- Reports including waveform tracings will continue to be faxed according to current practice and will remain available in Alberta Netcare.
