



Use MyChart to see your health records online

See your medications, get your health results faster



All Albertans over the age of 14 can now see their health care records online using MyChart.

Please note that physicians without access to Connect Care (family doctors) are not able to support MyChart at their community clinics.

MyChart is an online tool that gives you access to your Connect Care health records such as your medications, upcoming appointments, lab test results, etc.


Download the app called MyChart on your mobile device.

! Keep in mind, MyChart is only one way to access your health information. You and your authorized representative are key members of your health care team and can communicate with the rest of your team through phone calls and visits.

Youth aged 14 and older can sign up to access their health information electronically. You will need your own [Alberta ID](#) or a learner's permit to sign up for an Alberta.ca Account. An Alberta.ca Account will give you access to sign into your MyHealth Records account and the two tools within it, MyChart and My Personal Records.

Until you're 18 years old, your parent or authorized representative will be able to request access to all your health information on MyChart through proxy access. MyChart proxy access helps your healthcare team share your health information with your parent or authorized representative. You can disable proxy access at age 16.

A parent or authorized representative's proxy access to their youth's health information via MyChart will automatically expire when the youth turns 18 years old.
